 both sides of Little black creek containing
 ten acres more or less and bounded on the
 North and East by lands of Mary W.
 Hancock on the South and West by lands
 of Thomas Melton

Together with all and singular the Rights,
 Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances
 to the said Premises belonging, or in any
 wise incident or appertaining.

To Have and to Hold, all and singular the
 said premises before mentioned unto the said
 D. B. Douglass his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs,
 Executors and Administrators, to warrant
 and forever defend all and singular the said
